**Five Torrance Anglers Qualify In Fish Derby**

SAN DIEGO — A flurry of last minute heavy albacore registrations, including the season's heaviest and its two closest rivals, have set the stage for the second of three major fish offs in the \$25,000 San Diego Yellowtail Derby next Friday.

The monster longfin of the lot, a whopping 38 pound 8 ounce, was decked on Bill Poole's Polaris by Jim Constantino, Spring Valley, but his happiness at leading the derby qualifiers was tempered by his disgust at his failure to enter the Boosters' Bonanza.

THAT FAILURE cost him a cool \$1128, for his big albie bettered the winning weight in the Bonanza albacore-tuna division by a full 3½ pounds.

Qualifying for the third and final period of the derby began Sunday, and continuation of the heavy run of albacore to the southwest of Point Loma was expected to jack up the minimum rapidly. At the same time, there were growing signs that the Coronado Islands yellows also would become a factor soon.

**Crowley Lake Fish Season Ends Sunday**

As the Sunday windup on the 1960 trout-fishing season at Crowley Lake draws near, the world-famous Eastern High Sierra "lair of the tacklebusters" remains remarkably free of algae, it was reported Monday by the Los Angeles City Recreation and Park Department.

In his Monday-morning telephonic report, South Landing Manager Warren Bahm said that the middle of the huge man-made reservoir is clear. There are a few weeds along the lake's shore, he added.

Bahm said that weekend angling merited a "fair" rating and several 2½ and 3-pound trout were checked in. Still-fishing with worms got the best results.

Bahm spiced his telephonic summary by reporting that Ace Ito, of Los Angeles caught a 12-inch, 15-ounce Eastern Brook trout on Sunday. It was the first of the 100,000 Brookie fingerlings planted in Crowley the fall of 1959 to be checked in at the South Landing.
