Garden Checklist

1. Gladiolus plantings should be let to dry off gradually after bloom, so continue watering them occasionally.
2. Protect bedding plants from the hot August sun for a few days after setting them out.
3. August feeding is the surest way to have roses through fall.
4. Plant citrus, avocado, all evergreen fruits now while the weather is warm. Shade young citrus trunks from the sun.
5. Bait for snails. Frequent baiting is needed for complete control.

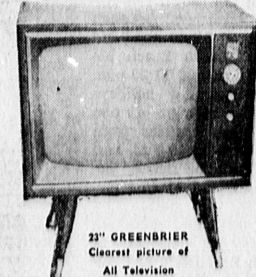
