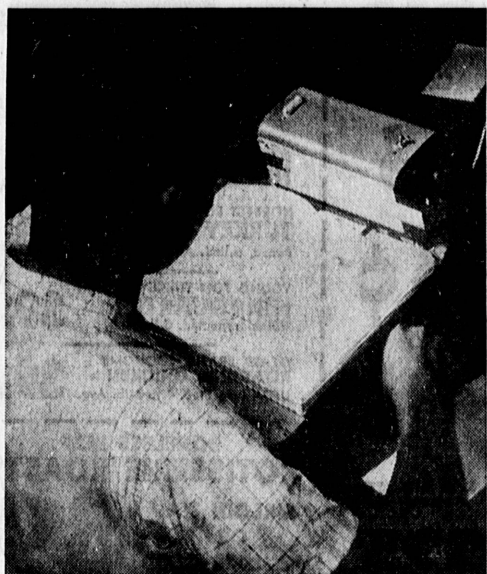

Speed Reading Course Resumed at Marymount

Because of the outstanding success of the Dan/Ro System Speed Reading classes at Marymount College during its first summer session, Mother M. du Sacre, president of Marymount College has scheduled additional classes before the beginning of the fall term which commenced Monday at the Palos Verdes Estates campus. The classes will meet every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday night at 6:30 p.m. and at 7:30 p.m.

The initial class began with an average reading speed of 277 words per minute with 60 per cent comprehension; doubled reading speeds in the first three to five hours and completed the course with an average speed of over 1000 words per minute with superior comprehension. They are now among the best readers in the nation!

The student, under the constant guidance of the reading specialist, trains with an individual tachistoscope to see more words and phrases at a glance. Pacing machines condition him to read at increasingly fast speeds with increased concentration and comprehension. These teaching machines plus the expert guidance of the reading specialist teach the student to read more quickly and with greater understanding, and enable the Dan/Ro System to guarantee a full 100 per cent improvement to every student.

Douglas Getting Machine Tools

Douglas Aircraft Co. announced today the placement of orders for 11 numerically-controlled profiling machine tools at a cost of over 3.3 million dollars.

This highly sophisticated equipment is being funded from the Air Force industrial modernization program for the purpose of updating the Air Force owned industrial manufacturing capability in the United States. It will be used to produce the complex parts required for space age vehicles at reduced cost to the government.

"DOUGLAS will participate in this effort by procuring with Douglas company funds four additional numerically-controlled machine tools.

Installation of this equipment in one of the Douglas West Coast plants will provide the largest concentration of such precise numerically-controlled machine tools in the world. There will be seven Giddings and Lewis five axis profilers, three large Giddings and Lewis three-axis DiMill profilers, two Giddings and Lewis four-axis vertical turret

lathes and four Sundstrand four-axis Omnimills. All will be equipped with the new Bendix "Dynapath" solid state control systems.

A Douglas selection committee composed of highly qualified experts from each California division recommended these tools from all available. Considered were the scheduled requirements for the complex machine parts necessary for the Skybolt production program.

ORDERS for the Giddings and Lewis equipment were placed with Dayton and Bakewell, while the Sundstrand orders were placed with Burgan Machinery Co., both machine tool distributors of Los Angeles.

Use of the Douglas-developed FASCAN (five-axis small computer application) and the industry-developed APT (automatic programmed tool) numerical control computer programs will enable the Douglas Company to obtain the highest degree of manufacturing capability from this large assortment of numerically controlled equipment.

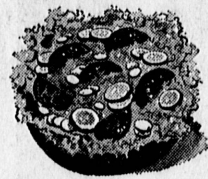

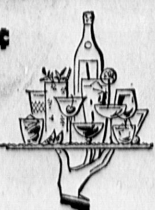
