Annual Pep Boys Award Goes to Montebello Boy

Stanley R. Tomer of Montebello today was announced as winner of the Ninth Annual Pep Boys Four-Year Engineering scholarship. The award pays for all tuition, books and supplies at any state college or university in California. Tomer will attend UCLA.

The award was officially presented to Tomer by Murray Rosenfeld, Pep Boys executive vice president and general manager in a ceremony at UCLA, also attended by Russell R. O'Neill, associate dean of engineering, and Joseph Kaplan, general manager of the Los Angeles Chapter of the National Safety Council.

TOMER IS the son of Mr. and Mrs. H. W. Tomer, 540 Morris Pl., Montebello. He was an honor student at Montebello High School where he was graduated last June. He won the scholarship in competition with high school students throughout Central and Southern California, the area of Pep Boys operation.

The award was made to Tomer on the basis of an essay on traffic safety, his score on an engineering aptitude examination, and his high school scholastic standing.

In addition to the scholarship, Tomer also received a \$50 savings bond and a trophy as one of the three finalists in the traffic safety essay competition.

OBJECTIVE OF the scholarship competition, according to Murray Rosenfeld, chairman of the scholarship committee is "to create a greater awareness of the need for traffic safety and to encourage youth to come forward with practical solutions to the problem."

The objective is accomplished by requiring competing students to write essays on the subject of, "What I Would Do to Prevent Traffic Accidents and Save Lives." The judging committee, composed of representatives from the California Highway Patrol, Los Angeles Traffic Court, UCLA, and the National Safety Council, was most complimentary on the ideas and suggestions contained in the essays submitted, according to Rosenfeld.

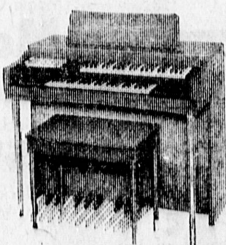
