

New Art Class For Teachers Added at LAHC

Art for Elementary Teachers, a college course with two units of fully transferable credit in the education curriculum, will be offered in the evening division at Harbor College for the first time during the fall semester, according to an announcement this week by Laurel Baker, chairman of construction and art.

The class will meet Friday evenings from 6:30 to 9:30 beginning Sept. 15. There is no prerequisite for the course.

Miss Verla M. Leonard, assistant supervisor of art education at Long Beach, will instruct in the course. Miss Leonard has earned her master's degree in art education at Stanford University. Her academic experience includes teaching and supervising of art from kindergarten through college in public schools of New York, Pennsylvania and California.

SHE HAS instructed are education courses at both San Francisco State college and Long Beach State college. Miss Leonard has had articles on art education published in "School Arts" and "Everyday Art" magazines.

The course, Art 10, Art for Elementary Teachers, is designed to develop in students their individual art expression through the use of a wide range of art materials. An evaluation will be made of each technique as it applies to elementary classroom teaching. Every effort is made to equip future teachers to better understand and fulfill the art needs of elementary children.
