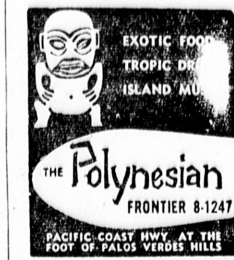
They also have a top selling album to their credit called "Tonight: In Person, The Limelites."
