

## Lions Clubs Set Dates For White Cane Drives

White Cane Days, sponsored annually by Lions Club, International, will be held in California and Nevada this year on Oct. 20 and 21.

The announcement was made by Wallace D. Dorman of San Diego, district governor of that area and chairman of the two-state council of governors.

He also announced appointment of Karl R. Barnum, Monterey Park pharmacist, as California-Nevada White Cane Days chairman for the fifth consecutive year. This year marks the 11th observation of the event, which has raised millions of dollars for sight conservation, providing aid to sightless and near sightless children and adults.

THE LOS ANGELES Foundation for Junior Blind is a major recipient in the Greater Los Angeles area and the Lions Hospital for Blind Youth in San Francisco is supported by Lions clubs in the Northern California region.

## Alondra Park Program for Tots Planned

Alondra Regional Park will offer a Tots Activity time for children three to five years of age.

This class is designed to give children an experience in playing with other children in a disciplined situation and varied activities not normally found in general home life.

These classes are limited and parents are required to assist in the class sessions. This fall the class will meet on Monday and Friday mornings from 10 to 12 noon. A child may be registered in only one class session.

Registration will be on a first come first serve basis at the time of registration only. Registration must be done in person on Monday, Sept. 18, 1961, from 10 a.m. to 12 noon. Only 100 children will be accepted for the classes. Proof of child's age may be required before entry into class.

## Two Classes For Mentally Retarded Set

Two recreation and craft classes for the mentally retarded will be opened next week under the auspices of the Southwest Assn. for Retarded Children.

The program will be held at Lennox Park, 10828 Condon Ave., in cooperation with the Los Angeles County Parks and Recreation Dept.

Pre-school classes will be for those aged one to five years and will be held each Friday morning from 9 to 11:30 a.m. Classes for those of school age and above will be held each Thursday from 1 to 3 p.m.

A combined registration and planning meeting has been scheduled for Thursday, Sept. 21, at the park at 1:30 p.m. Parents may bring their children at that time and help with the planning for the fall program, according to Florence Schuster, spokesman for SARC.

## Garden Checklist

1. Start planting ranunculus and anemones this month for early spring bloom.
2. Fuchsias will continue to bloom freely only if faded blossoms and seed pods are removed. Water by overhead sprinkling so as to moisten the leaves.
3. If bearded iris develop spotted foliage, remove the infected leaves and spray plants with a fungicide.
4. Mildew can be a problem in September. Spray roses, begonias, dahlias and other susceptible plants with recommended sprays.
5. Sweet peas and other cool season annuals should go in at the earliest possible time.

## LAHC Has Openings in Accounting

Enrollment is still open in a wide range of classes in accounting at Los Angeles Harbor College, evening division, according to an announcement today by Edward W. Robings, chairman of the business division.

A one-semester course in bookkeeping and accounting, especially suitable for secretaries, small businessmen, and others not interested in becoming accountants, is offered on Monday evenings.

Introductory accounting courses are available on various nights of the week. These are designed for future accountants and college majors.

A COURSE in governmental accounting is being taught on Thursday evenings. This course includes accounting for budgets, tax levies, appropriations, revenues, and other special governmental applications of accounting.

Reversing the usual order in which the subject is taught, tax accounting for partnerships and corporations is being offered this fall, with the study of tax accounting for individuals being delayed until spring. It is felt that this will give those interested in studying these special applications a chance to take the course during the slack tax season.

INTERMEDIATE accounting is offered on Tuesday evenings. This is a course suitable for those who are preparing for the C.P.A. examination.

Registration for evening accounting classes at Harbor College will continue through today. Applications and registration permits may be obtained at the college admissions office.
