Area Man Has New Job

Scouts Road Test Slated

Driving ability and habits, and road courtesy will be checked as Explorers compete against each other for trophies at the annual Explorer Road-Day-O of the Los Angeles Area Council, Boy Scouts of America, Saturday.

Exploring is the Scout program for boys 14 to 18 years old.

Starting point has been announced as Los Angeles State College in East Los Angeles, according to H. C. Cornett, steward coordinator.

Explorers will leave from the college at 7:30 a.m. and return for an awards program about 4:30 p.m. Saturday.

THE 150-MILE route of travel is still undisclosed. Maps will be mailed to all participating Explorers just five days before the Road-Day-O.

There is no limit to the number of Explorers who may participate in the Road-Day-O. Each driver provides his own car and gas.

Along the route of travel, Explorers will negotiate automotive problems, participate in safety demonstrations and have their cars checked for safety. Non-licensed Explorers go along in each car as timers and navigators. They will be issued log books the morning of the Road-Day-O.

LUNCH WILL be provided at one of the check points on the route, and a pocket souvenir piece is given each Explorer participant.

Registered leaders, and fathers of Explorers, may be assigned as observers in participating vehicles.

All questions regarding the Road-Day-O should be directed to the Activities Dept. of the Los Angeles Area Council.

Working with the Activities Dept. in planning the Road-Day-O are the Dept. of Motor Vehicles, California Highway Patrol, and Automobile Club of Southern California.

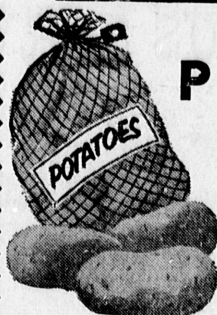
