## Call a Man a Communist and You May Have to Prove It in Court

At my request, the Legislative Counsel of the State of California issued the following legal opinion, No. 185, dated Sept. 5, 1961:

"Dear Mr. Chapel:  
"You ask whether in California calling a person a Communist is libelous.  
"It is settled that in California it is libelous to call a person a Communist. Justice Traynor, speaking for the majority of the court, in *McLeod vs. Tribune Publishing Co.*, 52 Cal. 2d 536, 343 P. 2d 36 (1959), held:  
"Whatever the rule may have been when anti-communist sentiment was less crystallized than it is today (citing cases), it is now settled that a charge of membership in the Communist Party or communist affiliation or sympathy is libelous on its face (citing cases), (52 Cal. 2d at 536).

ALTHOUGH I am not a lawyer, it is my own personal opinion that if you charge a person with membership in the Communist Party or communist affiliations or sympathy, and if you are brought into court by the person, you should immediately hire a lawyer whom you believe to be entirely patriotic and violently opposed to the Communist Party, persons with communist affiliations, and persons sympathetic with the objectives of communism.

Your lawyer will then explain to you the necessity for introducing evidence that the plaintiff (the person bringing you into court) is a member of the Communist Party, has communist affiliations, or is sympathetic with the objectives of the communists. This evidence may be difficult to obtain because since the enactment in 1953, of my Assembly Bill No. 52, cited as Chapter 1217, Statutes of 1953, and also cited as Sections 2540, 2540.4, and 2540.9, Elections Code of the State of California, the communists have not been permitted to place on the ballot at any election a person registered as a member of the Communist Party.

## Contract for Carson Area Signals Set

The Board of Supervisors has awarded a \$17,184 contract to William R. Hahn for the installation of semi-traffic actuated signals at the intersections of Avalon Blvd. with 189th and 190th Sts. in the Carson-Dominguez area.

The project was designed by the Los Angeles County Road Department and is scheduled for completion in November, 1961, Supervisor Burton W. Chace, who represents the area, said.

The traffic signals will provide safety for the school children of the adjacent public school. In addition, these traffic signals are necessary to provide specific right-of-way streets and to provide better continuity of traffic flow on Avalon Blvd., a County Master Plan Major Highway.

Chace said another traffic signal installation in the Willowbrook area at the intersection of Imperial Highway and Mona Blvd. is included in this contract.

advantage in registering as communists, but have registered as members of one or more of the other parties in California.

However, if they have made speeches, written articles for magazines and newspapers, or written books, advancing the communist cause, or if they have been active in organizations advancing the communist cause, evidence of such writing, speaking, or activity may be admissible as evidence in court, and you may win your case.

## Carson Area Road Project Announced

Supervisor Burton W. Chace has announced three more roadway projects for the Carson area.

They include an allocation of \$3800 for an 0.15 mile roadway improvement project on 208th St. easterly of Vermont Ave. Work will consist of extending the pavement on the south side of the roadway to join curb and gutter recently constructed by subdividers in the vicinity. In addition, the full width of the roadway surface will be sealed.

A \$1850 project at the intersection of Carson and Figueroa Sts. will begin this week. It will consist of reconstructing and remodeling the roadway shoulders on both sides of Carson as it approaches Figueroa to provide additional traffic lanes.

The project on Francisco St. from Figueroa St. to Main St. is progressing as scheduled, Chace said, and work will continue the rest of the week. Work will consist of grading and paving the roadway. It will provide roadway structural improvement, thus increasing driving safety and reducing present roadway maintenance costs, Chace said.

## Final Stamp Plan Offered By Cabrillo

This offer applies to new accounts, as well as to additions to existing accounts, says Strohmer.

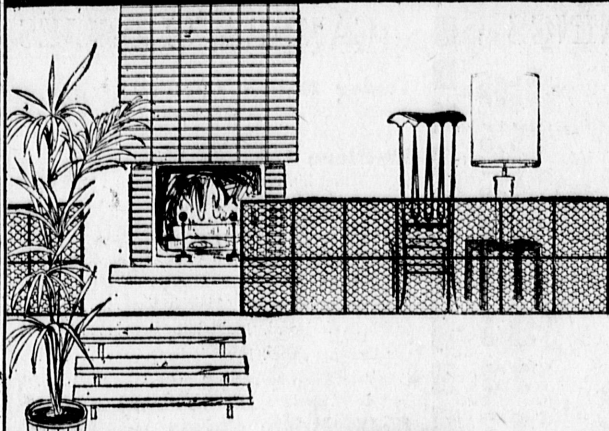
