# Verry Condition Better

Still in serious condition at Washo Medical Center, Reno, Nev., Coach Norm Verry of El Camino College was reported "improved" at 8:12 a.m. today.

The 39-year-old coach, stricken by a brain hemorrhage while flying with his team for Saturday night's football game in Boise, Idaho, was rushed to the Nevada hospital following an emergency landing in Reno.

In a telephone conversation with President Stuart E. Marsee this morning, Mrs. Verry, who flew to her husband's bedside Saturday, expressed complete confidence in treatment which he is receiving in the Nevada city.

GIVEN immediate attention by Dr. Anthony Volante, team physician, when he was taken ill over Lake Tahoe, the coach was later attended by Dr. Robert Broadbent and a neuro-specialist, Dr. Charles Fleming of Reno.

Mrs. Verry indicated that doctors plan to keep the grid coach in the Reno medical facility until Thursday, when they are hopeful of sending him to Los Angeles by air ambulance for an extensive series of tests. Doctors advised that these examinations be conducted nearer his home.

CONSCIOUS, he shows no evidence of paralysis and suffers only with a severe headache.

With Verry, in addition to his wife, is a sister.

WITHIN 10 minutes of the moment that his symptoms were detected aboard the chartered Western Airline flight, the emergency landing was made at the Reno airport, where Coach Verry was removed from the plane to the medical center.

Ironically, the head mentor of the El Camino College team, an All-American lineman for the University of Southern California during his college days, suffered a concussion on Lake Tahoe while water skiing there several years ago and

was treated in the identical center at that time.

LEAVING THE college party at Reno, Dr. Stuart E. Marsee, ECC president, and Merl F. Sloan, director of personnel, remained at the medical center, notifying Mrs. Verry of her husband's condition and making arrangements for her arrival later that day. The plane picked the pair of college administrators up for the return trip early Sunday a.m.

College officials lauded air-line and terminal officials for their swift action in assisting the popular grid coach, who led his Warrior team into the Junior Rose Bowl against Hines Junior College of Mississippi in 1954.

JUST PRIOR to take off from L.A. international Airport Saturday morning, Verry said, "This will have to be the year." He held high hopes for the current football squad, considered the most promising since 1954.

In Boise, stunned by the loss of their coach, physically shaken by Idaho's 28-degree temperature, (and playing without the services of two of their

coaches), the Warrior team fell 70-22 to the Boise Broncos, a powerful threat in junior college grid circles this season.

VETERAN COACH Doug Essick will take over the reins for the Warriors, for the remainder of the season, assisted by Coaches Don Jurk and Ken Swearingen, who assumed leadership of the team in Boise. A third assistant will be

named this week.

Regarded as one of the outstanding coaches in Junior College football nationally, Coach Verry is particularly recognized for his work with linemen. "Deeply concerned with the welfare of individual players under his jurisdiction, he has earned an unusual measure of esteem within the college community," Hamilton M. Madda-

ford, assistant director of student personnel at El Camino College, observed.

OFFICIALS of the Associated Students, concerned about the potentially high medical cost involved in the coach's illness, have indicated their desire to come to the aid of the Verry family, should this be necessary.

The coach, his wife, Lois, and their two sons reside at 864 11th St., Manhattan Beach.

## Doug Essick Named To Replace Verry

Doug Essick has been named to replace Norm Verry as head football coach at El Camino College. Verry suffered a cerebral hemorrhage on flight to last Saturday's football game in Boise, Idaho, and it appears as though he will not be able to resume his coaching duties the rest of the season.

Taking Essick's position on the staff will be Paul Manahan, it was announced yesterday by El Camino officials.

Assisting Essick, besides Manahan, will be Ken Swearingen and Don Jurk.

Essick is the former head coach of Inglewood High School and is a veteran end coach for the Warriors.

"Trying to fill the shoes of such a capable and outstanding coach as Norm Verry is going to be a really difficult challenge," stated Essick, "With the full cooperation of the

coaches and the team, I'm sure we'll do a respectable job," he added. Essick concluded, "We'll do the best we know how, anyway."

El Camino will go into its first game under the new head coach this Saturday night when they meet perennially rugged Weber College of Utah.

Last season the Tribe took the Wildcats into camp 38 to 24 in an upset of the previously undefeated Utah eleven.
