

Church of Christ Slates Climax To Month Long Attendance Drive

Climaxing a concentrated, month-long Bible School Attendance Drive, the Redondo Beach Church of Christ, 6122 Pacific Coast Hwy., is expecting a record attendance in its Bible School Sunday.

Under the direction of Thomas E. Tucker, 28025 Metfield Drive, the Bible School drive has been designed to coincide with the opening of the public school year. All classrooms have been refurbished, classes graded for all ages, and many other improvements have been instigated.

SPEAKING ON the importance of the teaching program of the church, Dr. Warren S. Jones, minister, of the Redondo church stated:

"Jesus laid the foundation for the teaching program of the church in his personal ministry. The success of the church, its growth in numbers, devotion, and knowledge is dependent upon teaching. Jesus has been called the master teacher and such a title is most appropriate.

"Jesus made it clear what should be taught, how it should be taught, and the results to be expected. Truth makes us free and it was Jesus who said 'Ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.' John 8:32. The study of philosophy is man's search for truth about himself and the universe. The truth about God, His Son, His kingdom, man's sin and forgiveness, guidance and life, and eternal destiny are not to be overlooked in our search for

truth. Truth can never contradict truth.

"THE METHOD of teaching truth is left to man's ability. Whether one teaches from the pulpit, in the classroom, on television, radio or through the printed page is entirely a matter of expediency but whatever the method chosen, it should be the best of which we are capable.

"Jesus taught us to expect results from teaching truth. When truth is properly taught and received, it will always bring results. Freedom, forgiveness, and fellowship are some of the results of truth.

"THE TEACHING program of the early church had a three-fold purpose. Conversion, communion, and consecrated service were the aims of the early church. In the conversion process brought about by the proclamation of truth, people were enabled and inspired to accept Jesus as the Christ.

"A second phase in the purpose of the teaching program of the early church seems to have been communion or fellowship. By nature, man is a social creature and will tie himself with other beings for fellowship. The greatest fellowship is to be found in God's church. Teaching, then, must be geared to lead the saved to observe the teaching of Christ, that they might escape the corruption of the world and partake of the divine nature," the Rev. Dr. Jones said.

"A THIRD purpose of the teaching program of the church is to bring people into consecrated service. In the Ephesian letter, Paul laid groundwork for the teaching program of the church and that here the purpose of the entire program was to bring us to a mature faith in Christ. Eph. 4:11-16.


"In view of the importance of God's truth and a task of handling that truth aright is the task of the church to secure and train adequately teachers and church leaders. Teachers and other leaders must be taught and trained by the church to fulfill the mission which God has given us," he said.

"THE TRUTH of God's word is the content of the church's teaching program. Christ must be presented inspiringly as the

Son of God, man's savior, friend and Guide. Such a presentation of Christ will produce results. It will bring about genuine conversion to Christ as a person; and it will enrich and develop Christian character; and lead to fuller and more consecrated Christian service. It will bring abundant life now and life with God in heaven." The public is cordially invited to attend Bible School each Sunday morning at 10 and all other services of the church, the pastor stressed.

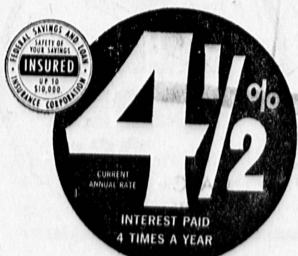
