

Pancake Feed Set by South Torrance Lions

Members of the South Torrance Lions Club will hold their second annual pancake breakfast Saturday, Oct. 28, at the shopping center parking lot, Pacific Coast Highway and Calle Mayor, it was announced here yesterday.

Serving will begin at 8 a.m. and will continue until 1 p.m. Proceeds of the event—at 50 cents a ticket—will be used in the organization's program of sight conservation and aid to the blind. In addition, the club enters into many civic activities, including aid to needy families of the area served by the club.

At the same time club officers announced that the annual glaucoma clinic held each year at Torrance Memorial Hospital has been scheduled for Friday, Oct. 20, from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. This is one of the sight conservation programs made possible from pancake breakfast proceeds, a club spokesman said.

Milestone Marked by Edison Co.

A milestone in the history of Torrance growth and progress was reached this week with the setting of Southern California Edison's 100,000th electric service meter in its local district.

According to Edison District Manager G. L. Blanchard, this indicates that more than 300,000 persons are now living in the district which includes Redondo Beach, Hermosa Beach, Manhattan Beach, Torrance, Gardena, Palos Verdes Estates, Rolling Hills, Rolling Hills Estates, Lomita, and the county area of the Palos Verdes Peninsula.

SITE OF THE historic meter setting was the new home of Albert McBride in Hollywood Riviera.

"It is fitting that the new home bearing this symbol of the area's progress has been awarded a Gold Medallion in recognition of its ultramodern electrical excellence," Blanchard said.

He pointed out that the 100,000th meter also is indicative of the Southwest's increasingly important role in Southern California.

Construction Due on Lomita Water System

Construction will begin in about two weeks in Waterworks District No. 13, Lomita, of a new water supply system of 6-, 8-, and 10-inch diameter lines, replacing an old and obsolete installation. Service connection and fire hydrants will be included in the work to bring the service in the section up to present day standards, according to Supervisor Burton W. Chace.

The area to be served lies between Crenshaw Boulevard and Narbonne Avenue on the east and west, and 241st Street on the north and Lomita Boulevard on the south.

Ten contractors submitted bids to County Engineer John A. Lambie ranging from a low of \$48,488 to \$66,835 with the Card Construction Company, Inc. of Newport Beach the apparent low bidder.
