

Senator Flays Delay In Area State College

State Sen. Richard Richards has blasted the "delay and apparent insufficient concern of the Board of State College Trustees in setting up the new State College in the Southwest area of our county."

Richards, who authored the bill creating the college, stated that as far as he could determine, "not one meeting has been held to even discuss a possible site for the new school."

THE SENATOR included these observations in remarks at an open meeting at the Silver Spur Elementary School Auditorium, Palos Verdes, Sunday. He further stated that the college is designed to serve that entire important area south of Santa Monica and west of the Harbor Freeway, including Torrance and Palos Verdes.

"Since the Governor signed the bill in 1960," he continued, "it seems to me that something should have been accomplished by now."

"THERE are already nearly two million people in the Southwest area; this will increase to three million by 1980. The Southwest area is destined to eventually contain approximately one-fourth of

the total population of Los Angeles County," he said.

"It behooves us to plan ahead to be certain that our educational facilities will be adequate to meet the increased needs of this vital area."

"State college full-time enrollment will approach 82,000 have strengthened this system prepare, now, to insure the continuing high standard of our educational product."

"CALIFORNIA already has one of the finest school systems in the nation and we have strengthened this system even more with recent state legislation upgrading academic requirements for teachers, setting up a state-wide testing program to evaluate individual district performance, and providing special programs for gifted children. It is further noteworthy that, by 1965, all public schools will be teaching languages, beginning in the sixth grade."

"Much has been done, but much more remains to be done. The state college here is another big step in the progress of our area and our people. I urge the trustees to implement the enabling legislation with all possible speed."
