## Church Opens Campaign to Find Old Sewing Machines for Korea

Remember the treadle sewing machine, that work horse for mother and plaything for junior, on which America sewed her way to greatness? Are there any still around? The local Seventh-day Adventist Church, 1610 Acacia Ave., wants to know. They want to answer an urgent "person-to-person" request from Korea with them.

Mrs. Myrtle Gilman, 24704 Oak St., Lomita, health and welfare service director of the church, explains that Adventist welfare workers in Korea have requested the aging machines to aid in preparing clothing and blankets for needy persons in that country to meet the on-coming winter.

"THESE MACHINES will be used in areas where electricity is not available," Mrs. Gilman explains, "and the treadle sewing machine is the only answer. Many thousands of Koreans will benefit from this simple gesture of goodwill on the part of America," the church welfare leader said.

Mrs. Gilman said the machines will be taken from the local church to the Adventist's Southland Welfare Headquarters at 3131 Pasadena Ave., Los Angeles. From that point they will be sent to the church's west coast overseas disaster-welfare center at San Jose and transshipped to Korea, where they will be distributed by Adventist welfare officials in that country to local community welfare units making the requests.

## Lesson-Sermon On Salvation Next Sunday
