## Credential Test Slated For Teachers

Local residents requiring constitution examinations to obtain teaching credentials will be able to take the test at 4 p.m. Friday in Room SS-6 at El Camino College.

Constitution requirements may also be satisfied by completing the course in Political Science 1, covering the governments of the United States and California. The course is worth three units.

Students may take this course in spring or fall and during the summer session.

Test material has been taken primarily from the Constitution of the United States. Any standard college text may be used as a reference.

The division of social sciences suggests the following works as helpful: "Principles of American Government" by Saye, "Faith of Our Fathers" by A. J. Cloud, and "Your Rugged Constitution" by Bruce.

These classes are an educational service of the Los Angeles County Health Dept. They were organized for the patients of private physicians and to supplement his teachings. In no way do they take the place of early and adequate prenatal care. The consent of the private physician is needed to continue in the class.

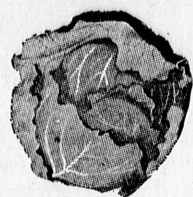

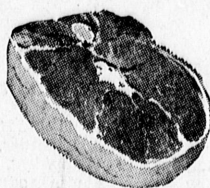
