Step Up Plans to Help Laid-Off Douglas Workers

A second meeting of the placement committee, set up to find new jobs for Douglas El Segundo workers being terminated in 1962, was held in the company's headquarters recently.

Notification will be given in December to all employees whose jobs are expected to terminate during early January, it was announced by K. G. Farrar, Douglas Aircraft Co. vice president-manufacturing.

Placement Committee representatives from the Douglas Aircraft Co., U.S. Navy, International Association of Machinists, and the California State Employment Agency, are coordinating their efforts and workers with available local jobs immediately following the December announcement, Farrar said.

Committee plans include temporary expansion of regular California State Employment Service Facilities. Special interviews and job placement areas will be furnished on company premises. The Douglas Co., U.S. Navy, and union officials will also cooperate in locating jobs for the laid-off workers, working with

the State Employment Agency and through its offices. An intense program will be

undertaken to notify all prospective local employers who can offer job openings. Members of the committee group have emphasized their determination to locate new employment for a maximum number of job workers, Farrar stated.
