Armed Forces

Army PFC James M. Neal, son of Mr. and Mrs. Jesse M. Neal, 21527 Berendo, graduated from the Seventh U. S. Army Non-Commissioned Officer (NCO) Academy in Bad Tolz, Germany, Nov. 3.

Neal received four weeks of training in various subjects with emphasis on leadership and combat tactics. The purpose of the academy is to broaden the professional knowledge of the soldier and to instill in him the self-confidence and sense of responsibility required to make him a capable leader of men.

The 22-year-old soldier, a member of Company B of the 3rd Division's 4th Infantry in Bamberg, entered the Army in October 1960 and completed basic training at Ft. Ord, Calif.

He was graduated from Narbonne High School in 1957 and attended Harbor College.

Army Sgt. Wayne E. Jordan, son of Mr. and Mrs. Clarence H. Jordan, 20947 S. Denker Ave., recently participated in a phase of field training Exercise Peace Maker in Germany.

The 4th Armored Division's 41st Infantry and its supporting elements participated in this phase of the exercise, which was designed to improve combat readiness. Sergeant Jordan and other unit members were also tested on their ability to operate under maximum realistic conditions in the field.

Jordan, a squad leader in the infantry's Company A which is regularly stationed in New Ulm, entered the Army in 1951, was last stationed at Ft. Ord, and arrived overseas on this tour of duty in April 1959.

He is a 1954 graduate of Fremont High School, Los Angeles. His wife, Donna, is with him in Germany.

ner, son of Mrs. Shirley Campbell, 1551 W. 214th St., participated with other members of the 3rd Infantry (The Old Guard) in the Presidential wreath laying ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier in Arlington National Cemetery on Veterans' Day, Nov. 11.

Known as "The President's Own," members of the unit are especially selected to serve as the President's personal honor guard and to perform ceremonial activities at high-level functions in the Washington, D.C., area.

Warner, a member of the infantry's Honor Guard Company, entered the Army in February 1960 and completed basic training at Ft. Ord, Calif. The 19-year-old soldier is a 1960 graduate of Narbonne High School.

Army PFC Ted D. Martizia, 20, son of Mr. and Mrs. Steve Martizia, 25502 Senator St., Harbor City, recently participated in Exercise Brandy Wine, a field training exercise involving some 26,000 troops in Germany.

He is a mechanic in Company E of the 32nd Signal Battalion which is regularly located in Darmstadt. Martizia entered the Army in September 1960 and received basic training at Ft. Ord. He arrived overseas in February of this year.
