privileges to all faculty organizations, including a chapter of the American Federation of Teachers.

In its Monday meeting the board unanimously decided to grant the AFT the right to use school rooms and mailboxes and to deduct organization dues from payroll checks.

THE BOARD'S action came in response to a request by Will Scoggins, president of AFT local 1388 (affiliated with the AFL-CIO). Scoggins pointed out that Assembly Bill 2375, passed by the state legislature last June, calls for equal access to school facilities for all employe groups.

El Camino College President Stuart E. Marsee recommended that the board implement this statute on the local campus.

SCOGGINS thanked the board for its action and pre-dicted that the union would expand its membership at the

expand its membership at the college.

"While I have great respect for the integrity of the CTA, it is only through the teachers' union that we can work effectively for the improvement of academic standards for our profession and for the students alike," he said.

"We will continue to port more rigid credential requirements, mutually negitia-

quirements, mutually negitia-ted salary schedules, and the preservation of the spirit of free discussion," he added.


