Improvement of Palos Verdes Boulevard from Pacific Coast Highway to Catalina Avenue, (Plan No. 87-105)

Notice is hereby given that the City Council has ascertained that the general prevailing rate of per diem wages in the locality in which work is to be done shall follow the provisions of Section No. 1770 of the Labor Code of the State of California.

Contractor is to perform all work as and when directed by the City Engineer.

Bids must be made on the special proposal form furnished by the City Engineer and must be accompanied by cash, certified or cashier's check or bidder's bond, payable to the City of Torrance, for an amount equal to at least ten per cent (10%) of the amount of the bid.

All bids are to be compared on basis of the City Engineer's estimates.

All bidders must be licensed as per Chapter 791, Statutes of 1929, as amended.

Plans, specifications, and form of proposal may be obtained at the Office of the City Engineer, City Hall, 3031 Torrance Boulevard, Torrance, California, upon payment of \$5.00 which is a charge and is not refundable.

The City Council of said City reserves the right to reject any and all bids received, to take all bids under advisement for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days after date of opening thereof, to waive any informality in any bid, and to be the sole judge of the relative merits of the material mentioned in the respective bids received.

ORDINANCE NO. 1281 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE AMENDING SECTION 25.253 OF "THE CODE OF

THE CITY OF TORRANCE, 1954 PROVIDING FOR THE COMPUTATION OF PAYMENTS INTO THE DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT FUND AND PERMITTING WAIVER OF THE FEE.

The City Council of the City of Torrance does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1.
That Section 25.253 entitled "Computation of Payments" of Chapter 25 of "The Code of the City of Torrance, 1954" is hereby repealed and the following provisions substituted therefor to read in their entirety as follows:

25.253. Computation of payments.

A. Whenever any lot or any portion thereof is improved, subdivided or divided on or after September 1, 1960, the owner thereof shall pay to the City the sum of \$50.00 for each acre of land in the whole of said lot; provided, however, that:

1. When the area of such lot is a fraction of an acre there shall be paid for such fraction

an amount equal to that portion of \$50.00 as such fraction bears to one acre.

2. When the area of such lot is equal to one acre or more the fee shall be calculated only on the portion thereof which is to be improved, but the payment shall be not less than \$100.

3. Land dedicated as a public way shall not be considered in determining such acreage.

4. The fee shall be waived for any property which is included in a drainage assessment district approved by the city council and formed after September 1, 1960.

5. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection A of this section and prior to the expiration of the term of the improvement thereunder in due by reason of construction of an improvement to a lot not then being subdivided or divided, the following provisions shall govern:

1. The fee shall be waived when such improvement in the opinion of the director of public works, is a temporary building or structure.

2. The fee shall be waived

when such improvement (a) is an alteration to existing improvement on a lot or portion thereof, and (b) in the opinion of the director of public works, does not result in a material diversion or increase in surface water runoff.

SECTION 2.
Any provision of the Torrance City Code, or amendments thereto, inconsistent herewith, to the extent of such inconsistencies and no further, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3.
This ordinance shall take effect thirty days after the date of its adoption and prior to the expiration of fifteen days from the passage thereof shall be published at least once in the Torrance Herald, a weekly newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of Torrance.
