New sections of the Health and Safety Code passed at the last session of the legislature provide that all pupils newly admitted to any school in the spring 1962 semester must provide proof of immunization.

"This applies to all new students, including adults, in both public and private schools from kindegarten through the junior college and adult education level." sa id McMasters.
