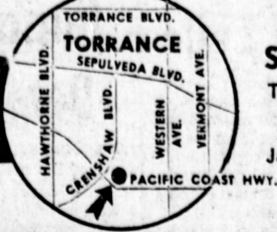

Gala Dessert Dresses Up Simple Meal

Revive memories of the fancy feasting of your youth with this rich-flavored Peach Mince-meat Dessert.

Squares of crunchy oat mixture filled with peach slices and mince-meat, topped with brandy-flavored sauce, make a good dessert.

It's a delightful way to dress up a soup and salad supper.

PEACH MINCEMEAT DESSERT

- 1 (1 lb. 13 oz.) can cling peach-slices
- 1/2 cup butter
- 1/2 cup brown sugar, packed
- 1 1/4 cups sifted flour
- 1/2 tsp. soda
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 1 1/4 cups quick-cooking oats
- 1/4 tsp. grated orange rind
- 1/4 tsp. Mince-meat Filling* Brandy Sauce*

Drain peaches, reserving syrup. Melt butter and combine with sugar, flour, soda, salt, oats and orange rind. Pat firmly into 9-inch square pan.

Bake at 375 degrees 15 to 20 minutes until golden. Top with *Mince-meat Filling made this way. Combine 1 1/2 cups prepared mince-meat, 1/4 tsp. orange rind and 1/4 tsp. ground ginger and mix well.

Top this filling with drained peach slices. Bake 10 minutes longer. Serve warm topped with *Brandy Sauce: Combine 1 cup peach syrup, 1 tbs. cornstarch and 1/4 tsp. salt. Heat, stirring occasionally, until mixture thickens and boils. Slowly stir in 1 beaten egg and cook one minute longer.

Remove from heat and stir in 2 tbs. butter and 1 tbs. brandy or 1 tsp. brandy extract.

'Soup's On' Rings Winter Dinner Bell

Carrots, onions, bell peppers, celery, tomatoes and cabbage can contribute wonders to your winter soup tureen.

Whether you start from scratch and use stock made from lean meat or a shin bone of beef, or whether you prepare soups and chowders from convenience foods or soup bases, use your own creative imagination with fresh vegetables, a different seasoning or an unusual garnish.

Serve Soup with Ceremony
Frosty nights suggest soups and the kind you serve must be chosen in relation to the rest of the meal. Thin soups introduce hearty meals while heavier soups complement lighter fare.

Serve soup with drama and ceremony. Search your cupboard for interesting containers.

The red and white checked tablecloth you reserve for Italian suppers can be used as background for French onion soup served from a copper pot.

- Variety Garnishes**
Green onions, celery cut on the diagonal, chopped chives, bacon bits, croutons, water chestnuts and chopped parsley are only a few of the garnishes which add splendor with a flair.
- CABBAGE-HAM SOUP**
2 tbs. butter
1 medium onion, chopped
2 branches celery, chopped
1 green pepper, chopped
3 cups boiling water
3 tbs. flour
1/2 medium head cabbage, shredded
2 cups cooked ham, cubed
1 tsp. salt
1/2 tsp. freshly ground pepper
1 cup dairy sour cream
1/4 cup dry white table wine
2 tbs. chopped parsley

Chili Potato Balls

Combine 2 lbs. whipped potatoes, one whole egg, melted butter, salt and chili powder to taste. Form into balls the size of plum.

Poke hole in center and fill with shredded cheese. Close hole and roll potato balls in fine bread crumbs or cereal crumbs. Arrange in well-greased baking dish and bake at 400 degrees until browned. Serve with tomato sauce.

Saute onion, celery and green pepper about 5 minutes in frying pan in butter. Blend in the flour and then with wooden spoon, stirring constantly, slowly add the boiling water.

Add cabbage, ham, salt and pepper and cook 8 to 10 minutes. Reduce heat or to 175 degrees if you have that control on your burner and add the sour cream.

Heat gently and add wine. Serve at once, garnished with chopped parsley.

CHINESE EGG-DROP SOUP WITH CELERY
6 cups chicken broth
1/4 cup minced celery
4 water chestnuts, chopped
1 tsp. monosodium glutamate
3 tbs. water
2 tsp. cornstarch
2 eggs, beaten
2 tbs. chopped green onions

Bring broth, celery, water chestnuts and monosodium glutamate to a boil. Mix cornstarch and water together. Pour into soup stirring constantly.

Spread beaten egg on surface of the soup as quickly as possible with a spoon. The egg will float like threads. Garnish with chopped green onions.
