Each bid must be made on the special proposal form furnished by the City Engineer and must be accompanied by cash, certified or cashier's check for 5% of the aggregate amount of the bid, or a check for 5% of the aggregate amount of the bid, payable to the City of Torrance, for an amount equal to at least ten percent (10%) of the amount of the bid as a guarantee that the bidder will enter into the proposed contract, if awarded to him. An affidavit must also be included stating that such proposal is genuine and not collusive or made in the interest or in behalf of any person not herein named, and that the bidder has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other bidder to put in a sham bid, and that the bidder has not in any way attempted by collusion to secure for himself an advantage over any other bidder. Any bid made without such affidavit or in violation thereof, shall not be considered. The right is reserved to reject any and all bids. Local sales tax will be taken into consideration in determining the low bidder.

 The above mentioned check or bid-bond shall be given as a guarantee that the bidder will comply with the terms of his signed bid; and if the successful bidder fails to comply with the terms of the signed bid, after acceptance thereof by the Board, his check or bond will be forfeited.
 Preference shall be given to supplies, materials or equipment produced, manufactured or grown in the State of California.
 The Board reserves the right to reject any and all bids, or any part of a bid, at its discretion, without any formality in the bids received.
