The course is designed to assist prospective parents in planning and caring for the new baby. All parents-to-be are welcomed.

During the first session, the film "From Generation to Generation" will be shown. This film illustrates the basic facts of human reproduction.

Later sessions will show films on childbirth, formula preparation, and Dr. Spock's child care, reported Mrs. M. Brown, PHN, nurse-instructor.
