

Scholarships Being Offered

Tuition scholarships valued at \$36,000 will be offered by Marymount College in competitive examinations scheduled for Saturday, Feb. 17, on the Palos Verdes Estates campus. Candidates must satisfy the regular requirements for entrance to an accredited college, and must rank in the highest quarter of their class. High school record must include three units of English, two of mathematics, one of science, one of history, and electives to complete the required total of 15 units.

Scholarships are of \$3,000 each, payable at the rate of \$750 for four years, and the student must maintain high academic and personal standards during her period of study for the bachelor's degree. Harbor Group Explains How to Choose Dentist

(This is the third in a series of questions and answers on dental health published by The Torrance HERALD, in cooperation with the Harbor Dental Society, in observance of National Dental Health Week, Feb. 4 through 10.)

I am new in my area and want to know how to go about selecting a dentist.

There are several reliable methods of obtaining names of reputable dentists in your area:

1. Telephone the office of the local dental society, if one is listed in the telephone book, and ask for the name of several qualified dentists. If there is no listing, write the American Dental Assn., 222 E. Superior St., Chicago 11, Ill., for information.
2. Ask your physician to recommend several dentists.
3. Telephone the chief of dental service or the attending dentist of an accredited hospital and ask him to recommend several qualified dentists.
4. Consult the American Dental Directory, which is available in libraries and hospitals, to learn the background of the dentist. This directory lists alphabetically and geographically every dentist in the United States and provides information concerning age, school attended, year of graduation, nature of practice and

membership in the American Dental Assn.

When I took my three-year-old child to the dentist for the first time, the dentist insisted I stay in the waiting room while he examined my child. Why is this?

Most dentists find the child will accept dental treatment more readily if parents are not present. Dentists also prefer that you bring the child in before any trouble develops so that the child may become accustomed to the dentist and the office. The appointment, if possible, should be in the morning since children cooperate better when they are not tired.

Some other pointers on the first visit:

- Don't offer a bribe to the child.
- Let the child learn about the importance and value of dental treatment from your attitude toward it.
- Make the appointment and keep it.
- Let the dentist do the talking.
