

Name Calling Art Ancient in Politics

 Name calling in politics is an ancient practice, probably going back to antiquity. As mentioned before in this column, a recent court decision held that it is an actionable offense to call anyone a Communist in California unless you can prove that the person called a Communist is indeed a Communist.

However, it is probably perfectly legal to call Communists by many other names without resorting to either profanity or obscenity.
 You can call them "reds," "Soviet sympathizers," "friends of Soviet Russia," "bolsheviks," "fellow travelers," etc., and it is doubtful if you are in any danger from them either through a civil or a criminal action. Likewise,

until our California courts decide otherwise, it is probably legal to call them "extremists on the far left," "liberal extremists," "left wing extremists," etc. However, before we attempt to exhaust the long list of legal synonyms for Communists, let us examine the exact meaning of "extremist."

Webster's New International Dictionary of the English Language, Second Edition, Unabridged, published by G. & C. Merriam Co., Springfield, Mass., 1949, on page 903, right column, gives the following definitions which shed light on the subject:
 "Extremism, n. Quality or state of being extreme; radicalism. — extremist, n. — extremist, adj."
 The letter "n" means noun and "adj." is the abbreviation for adjective. It is assumed everyone knows this but we should be complete in quoting the definitions. On the same page 903, and in the same column, appears this explanation:
 "Extreme left, extreme right. Politics. In some legislative bodies in Europe, the members seated at the extreme left or right representing respectively the most radical or the most conservative groups."

AMERICAN citizens of both the Democratic party and the Republican party want ideas and ideals which are logical. They want to implement these ideas and ideals with orderly action under the Constitution of the United States and of the State in which they live. They do not want fuzzy thinking, oratory in lieu of positive action, or hypocritical name-calling which directly or indirectly gives aid and comfort to the enemies of the United States, both domestic and foreign.

In other words, truly patriotic Democrats and Republicans realize that we are in a

cold war with Soviet Russia, it allies, neutral nations supporting the Russian policies, and people living in the United States who directly or indirectly help Russia and its allies.

COMMUNISTS and their allies, including those who deliberately or innocently follow the Communist party line, want the opposite of the American ideal. They put forth illogical ideas, attempt to confuse Americans regarding the real issues today, advocate aid and comfort to Russia and her allies, including the so-called "neutral nations" who follow the Russian line, and resort to smears and name-calling.

UNTIL FAIRLY recently, the Communist newspapers and magazines called anyone fighting communism a "McCarthyite" and used words "hysteria" and "hysterical" for discussing those actively exposing the Communist conspiracy.

You need not take my word for it. Go to any large library which has Communist publications and search the files. You will find what I say is true, but then you will find that within the past year the Communist press began to use the words "extremist" and "extremists" for those fighting Communists.
