Garrett Corp. Shows Healthy Year-End Gain
The Garrett Corp. in a report for the first six months ended Dec. 31, 1961 of its fiscal year, announced a net profit of \$2,526,228 or \$1.74 per share on the 1,449,822 shares outstanding. This compared with a profit of \$711,000 or 50 cents per share for the comparable period last year based on 1,421,997 shares then outstanding.
Current profits were from sales of \$99,421,987 for the six months period compared with \$94,506,000 as of this time last year.
"We believe these first six months of operation indicate a pattern of progress which we feel will continue through the remainder of the fiscal year," J. C. Garrett, president, said.
