

Gibson Picks Menveg to Direct Campaign

Heading Councilman John S. Gibson's campaign for county assessor is former Harbor Commission president, Lloyd A. Menveg, whose appointment as chairman of the Gibson for Assessor Committee was announced this week. Campaign headquarters have been opened at 706 Subway Terminal Building, 417 South Hill Street, Los Angeles.

"The enthusiastic support already expressed by civic and business leaders throughout the county for the election of John Gibson as assessor, adds

tremendously to my own enthusiasm in accepting this appointment," declared Menveg. "I have worked closely with John Gibson during the past eight years on matters of vital importance to the people of Los Angeles city and county," said Menveg, in accepting the appointment. "I consider him exceptionally well qualified for the important post of county assessor."

MENVEG NOTED that his terms as president of the Har-

bor Commission from 1954 to 1961 coincided with those of Gibson as president of the Los Angeles City Council.

"During this period, the Port of Los Angeles has experienced tremendous growth and development," Menveg continued. "As councilman from this district and as city council president, John Gibson deserves top credit for this expansion, which has involved millions of dollars—and has not cost the taxpayers one cent! In fact," he pointed out, "the port now brings an annu-

al net profit to the city of approximately \$4 million.

"From my own experience as harbor commissioner working with Councilman Gibson," stated Menveg, "I know that the increasing prosperity of our port affects not only the harbor area, but the entire county—in fact, all Southern California. This has given Councilman Gibson unique experience in understanding the interrelated problems of industry, business and population. Such knowledge will be invaluable in the fair and equitable

administration of the county assessor's office."

A NATIVE SON and second generation businessman of Wilmington, Menveg has also been associated with Gibson in civic and youth activities in the area.

"I have been impressed, not only with John Gibson's honesty and ability as a banker and a businessman," said Menveg, "but also with his deep feeling of civic responsibility.

"To John Gibson, the citizen comes first," the campaign chairman concluded. "He believes that election to public office means exactly what it says—service to the public.

The wife of a prominent Redondo Beach physician and the mother of six will review the book, "Dear and Glorious

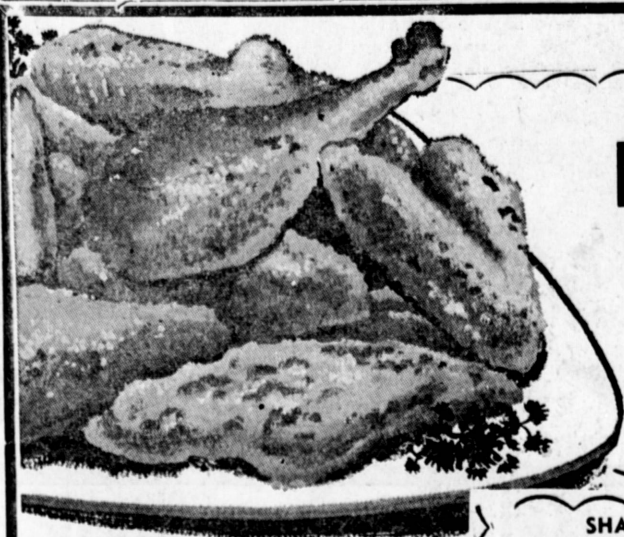
Physician," before members of the Women's Guild of Seaside Community United Church of Christ when they meet Tuesday evening at 7:30.

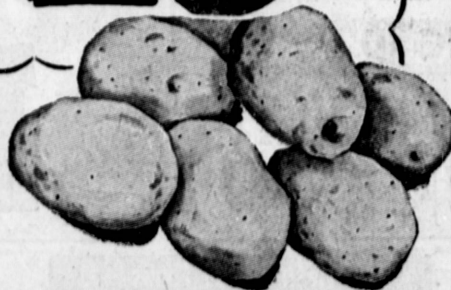
