Permit Granted for New Family Medical Center

Permit has been issued for the construction of the \$350,000 family type Crenshaw-Sepulveda Medical Center at 22600 Crenshaw Blvd.

Designed by the architectural firm of Rochlin & Baran, AIA, & Associates, the 12,000 square foot facility is being erected by Sokol Construction Co. of Beverly Hills.

According to C. J. Ammann of Professional Management Assn., coordinator and leasing agent of the project, occupants of the building will be established Torrance physicians and dentists, all with from five to fifteen years experience in family type practice.

AMMANN POINTED out that this unique structure, which has several years of planning behind it, was designed to foster the latest in family type medical-dental care and preserve the individual doctor-patient relationship. Suites have been customized to each doctor's needs and are conveniently located around a "central core" that will include x-ray and clinical laboratory facilities and a landscaped patio. The pharmacy will face the main lobby, which will contain a large brick fireplace. Latest in health education material, stressing the importance of early preventative medical care, will be available.

Each doctor will have his own separate examining, consultation, and reception rooms.

Lomita Street Improvement Funds Voted

A \$3,100 allocation by the Board of Supervisors means that the Los Angeles County Road Department can now schedule roadway improvements on Hendricks Avenue at 245th Street, Supervisor Burton W. Chace disclosed.

"The funds," he said, "were made available for the purpose of reconstructing the pavement at this location, to join curb and gutter previously constructed by adjacent property owners, and for the construction of a cross-flow gutter at the Hendricks Avenue-245th Street intersection.
