Man has a divine heritage of freedom and dominion, Elbert R. Slaughter of Dallas told a large audience here Monday. Dominion over the bondage of ignorance, poverty, and sickness is available to everyone through spiritual perception of the true idea of God and man, he stated. Slaughter, a member of the Christian Science Board of Lectureship, spoke under the auspices of First Church of

Christ, Scientist, Torrance, in the church edifice, 1750 Manuel Ave. The subject of his lecture was "Christian Science: What It Is and What It Can Do for You."
