## El Camino Whips Loyola, Hosts USC Nine Tuesday

Prepping for its big contest Tuesday against the University of Southern California varsity nine, El Camino College horsehiders dumped visiting Loyola, 7-0 on Friday. USC captured the National Collegiate baseball title last year, and according to all indications, possesses an equally strong varsity this term. Camino boasts a 4-1-2 mark for the practice season, and will have the advantage of playing on its home diamond. Game time for the contest will be 2:30 p.m.

Against Loyola, the Warriors clubbed in three first inning runs, and were never in trouble from that point on, as Ted Sprague and John Torok combined on the hill to limit the Lions to a pair of bingles.

## Undefeated EC Matmen Bid for State JC Title

Undefeated in dual meet competition at the completion of the regular season, El Camino College wrestlers will be grappling for the State Junior College Championship Friday and Saturday at Cerritos Junior College. Wrestling is scheduled to begin at 1 p.m. on both days.

El Camino wrestlers completed the last of their dual meets this season by out-grappling Orange Coast College matmen 25-11, culminating the season with a perfect 8-0 record.

Stomping last year's state champion, San Bernardino, 23-8, and the season's UCLA tourney championship team from Bakersfield College, 21-14, the Warriors also recorded impressive victories over Mt. San Antonio College, 21-13; Pierce College 39-0; Cerritos College, 33-7; San Diego State Freshman, 22-11, and San Diego City College, 34-3.

EL CAMINO 123-pounder Ray Pogue put both shoulders of Orange Coast wrestler Denis Strachen on the mat for a fall in 1:50 seconds of the third period.

Wrestling in dual competi-

tion for the last time for El Camino, 130-pounder Andy Harris lost to Larry Nissen from Orange Coast, 7-0.

JOHN ARNOLD, another two-year El Camino wrestler, battled opponent Tom Moran to a 1-1 draw, bringing the team scores to 7-5 in favor of El Camino. Arnold is undefeated in dual meet competition.

Don Holt, another ECC grappler undefeated in dual competition, decisioned 147-pound opponent Don Matson, 4-2. Warrior 157-pounder Ralph Freas, substituting for injured El Camino team captain, another second year man Dave Fiorelli, pushed Orange Coast man Larry Jobbins all over the mat before finally pinning him in 2:15 seconds of the second period.

RICK HANSEN, at 167 for ECC, lost a close one to Tom Caso, 8-6, in the closing minutes of the individual match.

Wrestling in his last dual meet for El Camino, 177-pounder Denny Pointon lost a decision to Jim McMahan 10-4.

THE 191-pound weight division match for forfeited to El Camino matman Tim Lutz, who also remains undefeated in dual competition.

Warrior heavyweight grappler Jim Miller, wrestling in his last dual meet for ECC, pinned Glen Miller, of Orange Coast, firmly to the mat in 1:34 seconds of the second period, making the final score of the meet El Camino 25, Orange Coast 11.

## Bay League Horsehiders Open Season

Bay League baseball gets underway Thursday with North meeting Redondo on the Seahawk diamond and South Torrance playing host to Morningside.
