The most common symptom of the infection is painful swelling of the largest salivary gland (parotid) on one side of the neck in the area below the ear. This usually appears about 18 to 21 days after infection with the mumps virus. Within a few days, swelling and ten-derness may also be experien-ced on the other side as well. In some cases, however, swellng may not occur at all.

THE PATIENT with mumps often experiences pain or dis-comfort in the area of one or both of the parotids for a few hours prior to any noticeable swelling, and this may be at first mistaken for an earache. Peculiarly, the eating of sour or highly seasoned foods tends to increase the discomfort. In most patients, during the first 48 to 72 hours of illness, fever and exhaustion are also pres-

When the illness begins as meningitis, symptoms, which include stiffness of the neck and back, are generally more severe, but prospects for com-plete recovery are excellent. Involvement of the sex glands Involvement of the sex glands is reported to occur in about 25 per cent or more of adult males afflicted with mumps and in about 5 per cent of the women. Since this occasionally results in sterility (about one per cent of cases in males), it is understandable that doctors generally make no effort to generally make no effort to prevent the disease in young

The source of the infection is the virus-containing saliva of infected persons. The disof infected persons. The dis-case may also be spread through contact with articles freshly soiled with the mumps virus. Coughing and sneezing are not characteristic of are not characteristic of mumps which helps account for the fact that the infection does not spread as quickly as some other communicable diseases such as measles or chicken-

MUMPS IS infectious a few MOMPS is infectious a rew days before the symptoms of the illness are apparent and remains so until the swelling disappears. Even in the absence of swelling, this period of infectivity persists.

A vaccine is available that
will prevent mumps, and this

is usually given to susceptible individuals past puberty—susceptibility can be determined by means of a skin test— in the event of an epidemic of the disease. The vaccine has limited value since the immunity it provides lasts only about two years and, consequently, since it is desirable that children have the disease before puberty, vaccination of the young is not recommended. Convalescent mumps serum may also prevent the disease or modify its severity in the event that it does occur.
