HERE ARE a few facts surrounding the situation. Since 1949 all broadcasting stations have been clearly authorized to take editorial stands on public issues. According to one survey only one-third of them do. And of that third only 14 per cent do so regularly.

A principal reason there has been little enthusiasm on the part of station owners is that they are also charged with "an affirmative duty generally to encourage and implement the broadcast of all sides of controversial public issues." This situation can lead to some sticky problems. Stations are also reluctant to be identified in the buying public's mind with specific positions.
