KEN MILLER SAYS

Vitality of Older Sections Holds Key to City's Future

"The vitality of the older, established sections of Torrance is going to be the key, in the future, to the well-being of all districts of this community," City Council Candidate Ken Miller said yesterday.
The City Council is going to have to face up to the problem of establishing policy for the redevelopment of older sections which are bordering on becoming substandard districts, he said.
"A blighted area in a community is much like a disease. It infects its neighbors, which, in turn, will infect another. This is in terms of costly increases in crime rate, welfare

services and redevelopment," Miller said.

ALTHOUGH THIS is not a serious problem now, it could become one suddenly. It would be wrong for the city to be caught in this situation without having the machinery ready to combat it, Miller pointed out.
"It is my opinion that the city should begin planning now for the possible decline and deterioration of some of the older sections. A wealth of information for redevelopment planning is available from Southern California cities which have been faced with this problem and have overcome it," he said.

MILLER SAID it would be unwise to see this happen in nearby communities and then say it can't happen here.
"I don't see any need to run to the federal government for redevelopment money and aid. The people of Torrance have shown their wisdom and ability to solve their own problems many times in the past.

"Even though this is not a major problem for us at the present time, we can prevent serious difficulty by taking action and planning now to prevent it," the Torrance Planning Commissioner said.

HE EXPRESSED doubt that such steps would or should affect the tax rate.

"However, if we don't begin to work on redevelopment plans now, it is very possible that some areas could become blighted almost overnight. These would immediately infect others. When this happens, it becomes costly for everyone to live with it and even costlier to correct it," he said.

"This is about the same as putting a bandage over a small cut on the finger to ward off a serious infection, one which could require expensive treatment if not given proper care early."
