#### Local Firm To Work on Rocket Part

In what is a major develop-ment in the U.S. race to the moon, the Tylan Corp. of Tor-rance has been selected by the National Aeronautics and Space Administration to develop a ground check-out power supply system for the Saturn

moon rocket.

The 10-story Saturn booster vehicle, now under construction at the Marshail Space Flight Center in Huntsville, Ala., weighs over a million pounds. It is scheduled to be operational in 1964 for sending the three-man Apollo spaceoperational in 1904 for sending the three-man Apollo space-craft to the moon and to boost a space station into orbit around the earth.
