## Civic-Symphony to Give 'I Pagliacci' April 8

An opera written by a cafe pianist and performed by the first time just 70 years ago will be the April 8 production of the Torrance-South Bay Civic Symphony at the Redondo Beach High School Auditorium.

"I Pagliacci," which contains probably some of the most familiar arias in classical music, was written by Ruggiero Leoncavallo, who had been eking out a wretched living with hack work as an accompanist and cafe entertainer. He turned out the lyrics and composed the music — an amazing accomplishment — and said he didn't see how any one could set words successfully to the music of another.

SELECTED by director Elyse Aehle for the April 8 performance have been soloists Ann Bethel as Nedda; Mario Leonard, Canio; Enrico Porta, Tonio; Paul Ashton, Silvio; and Ray Gagan, Beppe.

The entire opera, except for one short chorus, will be performed by the Civic Symphony, conductor Aehle reports. The soloists will be costumed, and the orchestra of 80 pieces will be on a stage to give full

force to the great music which is the focal point of interest.

Many prominent musicians will be featured among the orchestra personnel in addition to its distinguished conductor.

AMONG THOSE will be Harry Nelson, former first flute of the Royal Philharmonic of London and father of Zara Nelson, world-renowned cellist; Elizabeth Holborn and Syd Skammer, who have served as concertmasters under many great conductors; Sam Sarid, violin soloist from Boston; Bernard Verkaaik, national director of music for the Salvation Army; Ingevar Vaas from Holland; Barbara Marino, first flute of Long Beach; and Barbara Lundgren, distinguished cello soloist.

REHEARSALS are held each Monday evening at the Redondo Union High School auditorium, Director Aehle reports. New players are always welcome, she says.
