Work Slated For Streets In Lomita

The County Board of Supervisors allocated \$2,000 for two roadway improvement projects in Lomita, Supervisor Burton W. Chace reported.

The pavement on Feijoa Avenue between 250th Street and 254th Street will be extended to join with existing curb and gutter.

The other project will be the same type of improvement on the west side of Narbonne Avenue at approximately 0.2 mile south of Pacific Coast Highway.

Both projects will be scheduled by the Los Angeles County Road Department pending the completion of other portions of the current work load.

Chace said Narbonne Avenue is a County Master Plan Highway presently carrying a daily average of more than 5,000 vehicles in this vicinity.

"The completed work," he concluded, "will improve area drainage, decrease roadway maintenance costs and add to the operational efficiency of both segments of county roads."
