Chace became Supervisor for the Fourth District in 1953 by appointment of Gov. Earl Warren. He was serving his third term as Mayor of Long Beach at the time.

His political career began in 1933 when he was elected to the Long Beach Board of Education where he served for eight years.

In 1945, Chace ran for the Long Beach City Council and was elected. In 1947 he was elected Mayor.

HE HAS served as a member of the Coliseum Commission and was president of the Commission when plans were completed for the Sports Arena. Elected chairman of the Board of Supervisors twice, Supervisor Chace voluntarily gave up the chairmanship in 1958 in order to devote personal attention to the Fourth Supervisorial District. He is chairman of many important committees. They include Civil Service, Assessor, Parks and Recreation, Purchasing, Public Administrator, and Sealers of Weights and Measures.
