

Air Force Offering Study Aid

The Air Force, through its Officer Training School, is now offering an opportunity for college graduates with the necessary scientific and engineering background to continue their work toward a graduate degree.

According to Sgt. James P. LeFevre, local Air Force representative, this new program is open to graduates of Officer Training School, a three month course leading to a commission as a second lieutenant in the Air Force. After completion of OTS, qualifying officers have the opportunity for direct entry into the Air Force's Institute of Technology Scientific and Engineering program to complete their study for a graduate degree.

THE PROGRAM is offered to students in many fields, including weather, aeronautical engineers, electronics engineering, mechanical engineering, communications-electronics, guided missiles, armament, aircraft maintenance, civil engineering, and cartography.

In addition to the educational requirements, to qualify for the Institute of Technology, students must complete OTS with a final performance standing in the upper 20 per cent of their class, based upon academic and military performance rating, Sergeant LeFevre explained. Only college graduates can enter OTS; however students, both male and female, may make application up to 210 days before graduation. 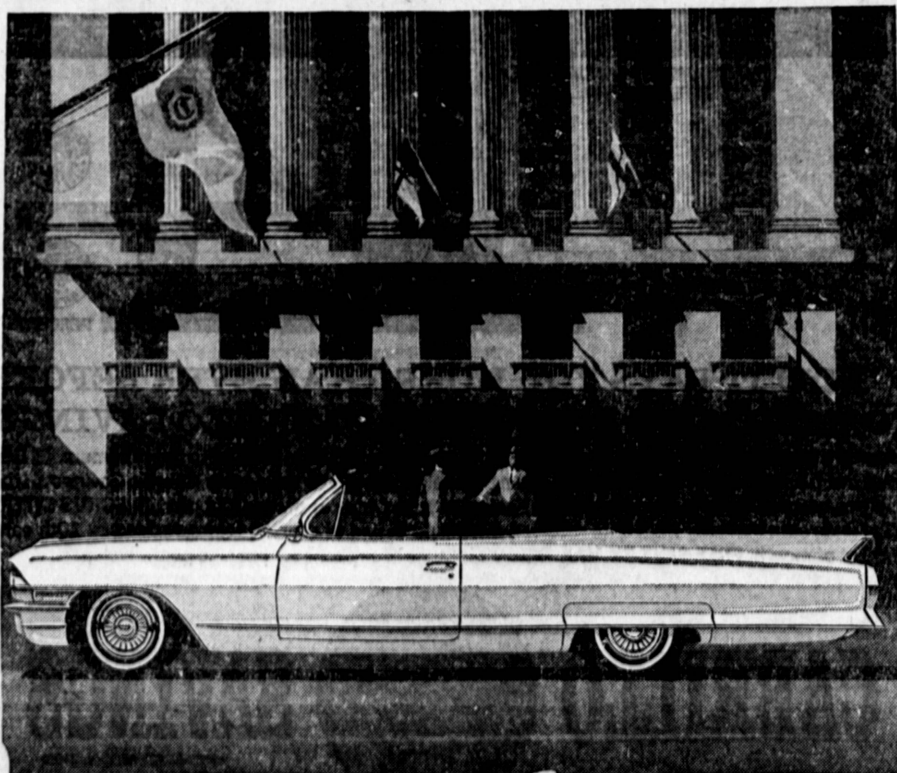

SKILLET PEPPER STEAK

1 1/2 lbs. Skillet Steak, 1/2" thick, cut in serving pieces

1/2 Cup Onion, sliced, 1 Cup Garlic, minced

1 Beef Bouillon Cube, dissolved in 1/2 cup water

1 Beef S&W Stewed Tomatoes

2 Cans S&W Stewed Tomatoes

1 Green Pepper, thinly sliced in rings

2 Tbs. Cornstarch, 2 Tbs. Soy Sauce

1/2 Cup Cold Water, Salt & Pepper to taste

Preheat electric skillet to 300 degrees. Melt shortening and brown meat slowly. Add onions, garlic, pepper and bouillon. Cover and simmer for 20 minutes at 200 degrees. Add tomatoes and green pepper and cook 10 minutes. Combine cornstarch, water and soy sauce, stirring occasionally. Cook 5 minutes longer, stirring occasionally.
