


WHEREAS this City Council proposes, as hereinabove more particularly set forth, to take proceedings under the Improvement Limitation Division of the Streets and Highways Code, for the construction of certain work and improvements in the City of Torrance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to conform to the provisions of Section 17 of Article XIII of the Constitution of the State of California, and Section 2804 of the Streets and Highways Code, as amended, a public hearing to be held by the City Council, as hereinbefore described, particularly provided to determine whether public convenience and general utility require said work or improvement, and whether the provisions of the Special Assessment Investigation Limitation and Major-Public Benefit Protest Act of 1931 shall apply thereto; DECLARING THE WORK TO BE OF MORE THAN LOCAL OR ORDINARY PUBLIC BENEFIT; DETERMINING AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

That the public interest and convenience requires that the City Council of the City of Torrance to order the following work to be done or improved, to be held by the City Council to be performed, where public convenience and necessity require said work or improvement, and whether the provisions of the Assessment Investigation Limitation and Major-Public Benefit Protest Act of 1931 shall apply thereto. Field hearing is hereby set for the same time and place as the regular meeting of the City Council.

SECTION 2.

That all aforesaid work and improvement shall be constructed at the gross dimensions and at the places and in the manner shown on the plans (which include plans for the proposed work) for the said work designated "Plan No. ST-77" consisting of two sheets numbered 1 to 2 inclusive, and in accordance with said plans and with specifications for said work, which are designated "Specifications for the Improvement of Cabrillo Avenue" from Sepulveda Boulevard to Lincoln Avenue, San Pedro Street, and sidewalks on Cabrillo Avenue.

WHEREAS by Resolution No. 41, adopted March 10, 1961, this City Council instructed the City Engineer to prepare plans, specifications and cost estimates for the construction of certain curb gutters and sidewalks on Cabrillo Avenue.

WHEREAS, at its meeting of July 11, 1961 this City Council moved to include grading and paving of Cabrillo Avenue from Sepulveda Boulevard to Lincoln Avenue, as part of the proposed improvement, and to make a contribution of funds to pay the cost of said work.

(Public Notice)

The estimated cost of said work or improvement, inclusive of incidental expenses of the proceedings, is the sum of \$21,330.55.

SECTION 3.

That the City Clerk shall contribute out of the treasury of the City from the County Gas Tax Street Improvement Fund for the cost of all work, as hereinabove described.

SECTION 4.

That pursuant to the provisions of Section 17 of Article XIII of the Constitution of the State of California, and Section 2804 of the Streets and Highways Code, as amended, notice is hereby given that the provisions of the Special Assessment Investigation Limitation and Major-Public Benefit Protest Act of 1931 shall apply thereto.

SECTION 5.

That the City Clerk is hereby directed to mail notices of the proposed work to all persons whose names are registered in the City Directory, to the City Clerk, to the Board of Education, and to the City Auditor.

SECTION 6.

That the City Clerk is hereby directed to mail notices of the proposed work to all persons whose names are registered in the City Directory, to the City Clerk, to the Board of Education, and to the City Auditor.

SECTION 7.

That the proposed work is to be done under and proceedings therefore are to be under and pursuant to the said Improvement Act of 1931.

SECTION 8.

That notice is hereby given that the 1st day of May, 1962 at the hour of 9 A.M. in the City of Torrance, the City Clerk and the Council Chambers of this City Council in the City Hall in said city of Torrance, in the place where the same is held, shall be holding any protest or objection to said proposed work or to the extent of said assessment district, or to the proposed work or to the extent of said assessment district, or to the proposed work or to the extent of said assessment district.

SECTION 9.

That the legal description of said

district is hereby made to a plat or map of said district hereinafter approved by this City Council in the office of the City Clerk, so designated "Cabrillo Avenue Street Improvement District No. A11-60-2, Plan No. ST-77-A," which map or plat indicates the boundary of the said district, the jurisdiction of the said proposed district, included and shall govern for all assessments due as to the extent of said assessment district.

SECTION 10.

That the City Clerk is hereby directed to mail notices of the adoption of this resolution as provided in said Improvement Act of 1931, postage paid, to all persons whose names are registered in the said Improvement Act of 1931.

SECTION 11.

That the superintendent of Streets and Highways of the City of Torrance is hereby directed to cause to be conspicuously posted in the line of the completed work on all open streets within said assessment district, notices of the passage of this resolution, its intention of the time, and date, and manner provided by this 13th day of March, 1962.
