## Dr. Kraus, Wife New Citizens

Dr. Henry E. Kraus, rabbi of Southwest Temple Beth Torah, and his wife, Clara, were sworn in Friday as American citizens.

Rabbi Kraus, recently appointed spiritual leader for Beth Torah at 14725 S. Gramercy Place, Gardena, escaped from Communist Hungary in 1947 with his wife and daughter, Marianna, and a few personal possessions. Among these possessions was his sacred Torah, the scroll that carries the Jewish doctrine.

Dr. Kraus, who received his doctor of philosophy degree from the University of Budapest, was ordained in Hungary in 1940. He was later imprisoned by the Nazis, but was freed from a concentration camp by Americans.

He became chief Rabbi of Western Hungary in 1946, a post he held until he fled the country in 1957.

Rabbi Kraus and his family now live in the Hollypark section of Gardena.
