Essay on Youth's Role in Foreign Policy Wins Prize

One of 10 finalists from an original 2,000 contestants throughout the nation, Mrs. Marcella Blechman of El Camino College was the recipient this week of a 24-volume 1962 set of Encyclopaedia Britannica.

Scholarships for graduate study were awarded to winners Carol Burns, a senior at Reed College, Portland, Ore., and Gerald Bongard, a junior at the College of St. Thomas, St. Paul, Minn. Seven additional sets of encyclopedias were given to other semi-finalists.
