

### Robert Eustace Chosen To Direct Boyce Drive

One of America's most successful Republican campaign directors has joined the staff of volunteer workers for Dr. Merle H. Boyce, Republican candidate for Congress in the 17th District. He is Robert J. Eustace of Washington, D. C., who has successfully directed scores of winning Republican

campaigns in areas with heavy Democratic voting strength. Eustace will serve as campaign director for Dr. Boyce. Eustace is no stranger to the Harbor area and the 17th Congressional district. He was the main speaker at a meeting in Wilmington last December when a "Citizen's Committee
