**Calle Mavor Students Get 'Gold Fever'**

The sound of water rushing through cradles, sluice boxes and Long Toms, so prevalent during the Gold Rush Days was again echoed last week at Calle Mavor Elementary School in Torrance, where students of Robert S. Matchett's fourth grade class actually "struck it rich" in a modest sort of way.

As a culminating activity of a social studies unit on California's Gold Rush era, the teacher visited the Placeritas Canyon, near Newhall where he gathered several boxes of sand from the stream bed about 20 feet away from the historical Oak of The Golden Dream under which Francisco Lopes first discovered gold in Southern California on March 9, 1862.

The ore bearing sand was then brought to the school where the children constructed working model-replicas of the 49ers' gold separating machinery. "The students" said Matchett, "found enough 'color' in the stream-bed sand to raise a good case of 'gold fever' which lasted for several days."

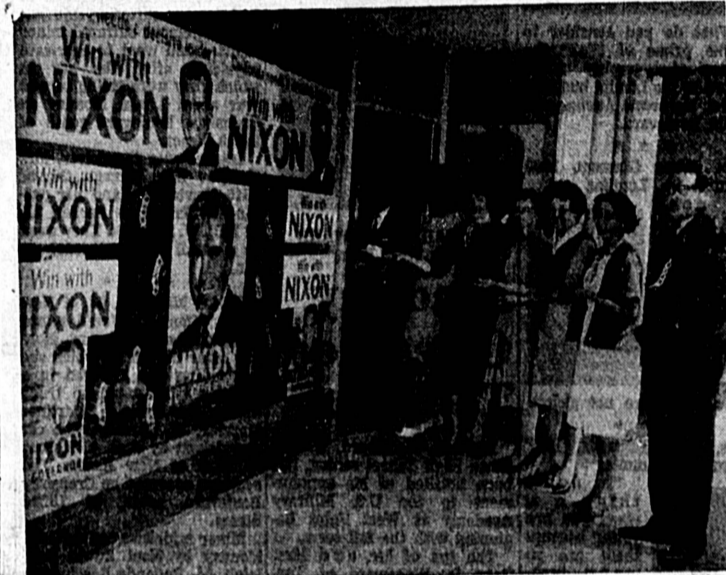
