## **Persons Traveling Abroad Get Advice**

Many a prospective traveler wonders why he ever planned a foreign tour when he discovers the health hazards he is liable to encounter in some of the countries on his itinerary.

The immunizations that are the disease appear formidable at times, but everyone who travels is wise to obtain whatevalve is strongly recommended it is strongly recommended that smallpox vaccination be obtained.

While one can leave this country without it, evidence of immunity to this disease must be shown before re-entry is a fermion of smallpox to the British Isles and Germany from Pakistan during the past six months, it

OWING TO the importation of smallpox to the British Isles and Germany from Pakistan during the past six months, it is advised that nonimmune persons travelling to these par-ticular areas be vaccinated against smallpox if more than one year has elapsed since it was last received.

Smallpox was introduced to these countries by air travelers, and the ease with which diseases such as smallpox and cholera can now be spread requires additional caution both on the part of the traveler and officials of the Public Health Service.

Inoculations against poliomyelitis, tetanus, typhoid, a n d paratyphoid fever are also advised in the event of international travel. This is not as bad as it may sound since many persons are already vaccinated against polio and tetanus, as indeed everybody should be even if they never leave home.

CHOLERA immunization should be obtained if the tour extends to parts of Asia, including Japan, and the Philippines, as outbreaks of the disease have occurred in certain parts of the Orient during recent months. In any event, it is good protection as the disease is endemic (always present) in that part of the world.

Yellow fever is prevalent in certain parts of Central and South America, Asia, and Africa and this immunization, unlike all others which may be obtained from private physics. obtained from private physicians, is given only by the U.S. Public Health Service, Room Public Health Service, Room 424, Federal Building, 312 N. Spring St., Los Angeles, Clinic hours are held daily from 1:30 to 2 p.m., Monday through Fri-

day.

The acquiring of these immunizations takes time, since some of them consist of several injections. It is therefore advisable to allow at least a month to comfortably permit completion prior to the departure date. They are all recorded on an Immunization Certificate which is usually given to the individual when given to the individual when Certificate which is usually given to the individual when his passport is issued. The certificate must then be taken (or mailed with a return addressed envelope) to the health center that is nearest the physician's office for the official stamp of approval stamp of approval.

VACCINATIONS may be giv-VACCINATIONS may be given concurrently or follow one after the other at the physician's discretion, with the exception of yellow fever and smallpox vaccination. These must be administered six days apart, although the order in which they are given is of no consequence.


Travelers in strange lands should also remember that sanitation standards do not al-

No milk should ever be consumed unless it is pas-teurized, and, if the tap water is suspect, not even used to clean the teeth. Recognized and reliable brands of bottled and reliable brands of bottled water should be taken instead. Crowded tenements may breed rats that become infected with typhus fever, and this disease may be transmitted to sight-seers by means of the rat flea.

ALL IN ALL, it seems like a very good idea to be prepared for all such health emergencies by getting the proper im munizations against them be fore leaving home. No holiday should ever terminate in avoid

should ever terminate in avoidable illness.
