AN ORDINANCE NO. 1318
OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA

SECTION 1.
That Section 9 B of Appendix I of "The Code of the City of Torrance, 1954" (Official Land Use Ordinance) is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor to read in its entirety as follows:

9 B. Front yard required:
No minimum front yard depth is required, except that any use permitted in zones R-1, R-2, R-3, R-R-3 and R-4 shall have a front yard not less than ten feet in depth.

SECTION 2.
That Section 10 D of Appendix I of "The Code of the City of Torrance, 1954" (Official Land Use Ordinance) is hereby repealed and the following provision substituted therefor to read in its entirety as follows:

10 D. Front yard required:
No minimum front yard depth is required, except that any use permitted in zones R-1, R-2, R-3, R-R-3 and R-4 shall have a front yard not less than ten feet in depth.

SECTION 3.
Any provision of the Torrance City Code or Ordinance heretofore inconsistent herewith, to the extent of such inconsistency and no further, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4.
That Ordinance No. 1317 entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 9 B AND 10 D OF APPENDIX I OF 'THE CODE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, 1954' (OFFICIAL LAND USE ORDINANCE), RELATING TO REQUIREMENTS FOR FRONT YARD SET-BACKS IN ZONES R-1, R-2, R-3, R-R-3 AND R-4, AND DECLARING THE PRESENCE OF AN 'EMERGENCY' IS HEREBY REPEALED IN ITS ENTIRETY, AND ALL PROVISIONS OF ALL ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE INCONSISTENT HEREBY ARE HEREBY REPEALED AND DECLARED NULL AND VOID.

SECTION 5.
This ordinance shall take effect on the date of its adoption and prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) days from the passage thereof shall be published at least once in the Torrance Herald, a semi-weekly newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of Torrance.
