Training Program Lures Over 500 Boy Scouts

Nine local residents will join more than 500 selected Boy Scouts who will participate in Cedar Badge training for junior leaders from June 30 to July 6 at the Lake Arrowhead Scout Camps.

From the Harbor area, Carl Ahee will be the Scoutmaster with Bill Moss and Milt Huber as his assistants.

Rex Scott, Hank Brightly, Earl France and Robroy Hamilton will assist Scoutmasters Jack Faucett and Richard Horgan from the South Bay area.

Norman Hopkins, vice chairman of the Council Training Committee, said the Scouts will learn the requirements for the First and Second Class ranks.

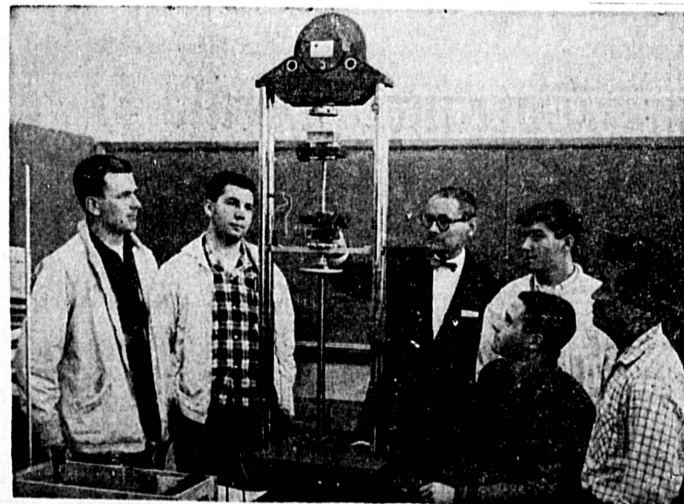
Hopkins said that Cedar Badge Scouts will "not only learn how to do a specific skill, but will learn how to have with it."

THE SCOUTS will live by the patrol method, rotating officers, so that each boy will have one day as Patrol Leader, as well as one day as assistant cook and 24 hours as tent cleaner-upper.

Scoutmasters for Cedar Badge are outstanding men in their communities, said Hopkins, selected for their ability to get along with boys and to administer a program.

EACH Cedar Badge Scoutmaster will have one or more assistants, many whom have been trained in Wood Badge Courses for adults.

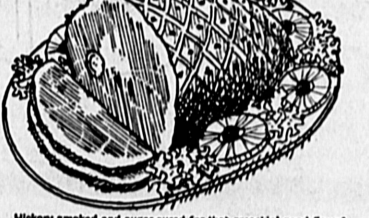
