1 tsp. vanilla

1 tsp. grated lemon peel

Cream shortening and sugar until light and fluffy. Add eggs and continue beating. Stir in vanilla and

Sift flour, baking powder and salt together. Stir into creamed mixture. Chill dough 2 to 4 hours. Roll out on lightly floured board to 4-inch thickness.

Cut into 2½-inch rounds,
Place half the circles on ungreased baking sheet.
In center of each, place teaspoon of pineapple filling,

spreading almost to edges.

Cut slit in remaining halves and place over filled rounds, sealing edges with tines of fork. Bake at 400 degrees 8 to 10 minutes.

PINEAPPLE FILLING 1/2 cup sugar

1 tbs. cornstarch

1 cup crushed pincapple (undrained)


