

New Bridge **Authorized** By County

A contract for construction of a \$498,816.95 bridge over Dominguez Channel at Figueroa Street was awarded to the John L. Meek Construction Co. Tuseday on motion of Supervisor Burton W. Chace.

Major phase of the work, Chase said, will consist of constructing a reinforced concrete T-gridder bridge at Figueroa spanning Dominguez Channel to provide an 80-foot roadway and sidewalks.

Included in the project is construction of a portion of the channel, in addition to concrete curbs, gutters and drainage facilities.
