Grand Opening Parties Scheduled at Charley's

Grand opening celebration for the newly remodeled Charley's restaurant at 1625 Cabrillo Ave. has been scheduled for tonight, Friday, and Saturday, it was announced yesterday by Charles Gotts, owner and operator.

On hand to entertain Grand Opening crowds will be Buddy Nolan, noted Southland organist, who is performing nightly except Monday at the popular new dining spot.

Menu features include lobster, steak, and prime rib dinners plus a wide assortment of luncheon and dinner selections.

AN ADDED attraction at the new dining center is a fashion show each Monday evening from 5 to 6:30 and on Tuesday and Friday from 12:30 to 2 p.m. Completion of the major remodeling program at the long-time Torrance restaurant which is being celebrated this weekend marks the transition of Charley's from a coffee shop-chuck wagon operation to one of the Southwest's finest luncheon-dinner houses.

DINERS MAY choose a table in the cocktail lounge and eat before the leaping flames of the fireplace; may select one of the comfortable, leather-covered booths along the middle of

the restaurant; or may dine at one of the tables in the main dining room.

Cocktail facilities include a long bar with padded elbow rests and an "organ bar" built around the electronic organ presided over by the popular Buddy Nolan. Nolan performs from 8:30 each evening except Monday.

Jaycees Schedule Seat Belt Clinic

Only one traffic death has occurred in Torrance this year, and the local Junior Chamber of Commerce will try to keep the figure from rising with a two-weekend seat belt clinic beginning Saturday.

This weekend and next, from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., the local organization will provide free installation of seat belts at the Del Amo annex in the north-east corner of Hawthorne and Sepulveda Boulevards.

For \$6 plus tax, the Jaycees will install a 6-000-pound test Caprolan nylon fabric belt, approved by the California Highway Patrol and the California

Junior Chamber of Commerce. Ten assembly lines will be set up and expert installation of front seat safety belts will be made. The belts come in seven different colors.

The clinic is a part of the official California Jaycee Belt Clinic movement approved by Gov. Edmund G. Brown.

New Bridge Authorized By County

A contract for construction of a \$498,816.95 bridge over Dominguez Channel at Figueroa Street was awarded to the John L. Meek Construction Co. Tuesday on motion of Supervisor Burton W. Chase.

The improvement was designed by the Los Angeles County Road Department and is scheduled to be completed in May 1963.

Major phase of the work, Chase said, will consist of constructing a reinforced concrete T-gridder bridge at Figueroa spanning Dominguez Channel to provide an 80-foot roadway and sidewalks.

Included in the project is construction of a portion of the channel, in addition to concrete curbs, gutters and drainage facilities.

Supervisor Chase said Figueroa Street will be closed to all but local traffic during construction. The County Road Department will provide traffic detours around the project. Anelo Avenue bridge will remain open until new access is provided to adjacent properties.
