Business, Industry Get Tax Break from State

California businessmen will get a tax reduction estimated at more than \$15 million annually under new rules approved by the Franchise Tax Board this week. The reduction is part of a move to bring California income tax rules into closer conformity with federal practices. "THE NEW RULES will make bookkeeping and tax paying simpler and should be particularly helpful to smaller business," said State Controller Alan Cranston, chairman of the board, in announcing the action. The reduction is also expected to boost the economic growth of the state by encouraging expansion and purchase of new equipment.

Bel Air Fire Film Available

"Design for Disaster," the film of the awesome Bel Air fire of November 1961, is now available free of charge from the General Telephone Co. film library, according to Bernard LeBaron, Palos Verdes Division manager. Schools, business and civic organizations, churches, or any recognized club or social group may obtain the film on a loan basis by calling the local business office of General Telephone Co. "Design for Disaster" is a 27-minute color film, produced by the Los Angeles Fire Department. The fire, the worst in Los Angeles history, destroyed 484 homes while laying waste to several thousand acres. Total damage was estimated in millions. There are 426 other films in the library, covering a wide range of subjects.

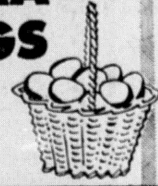

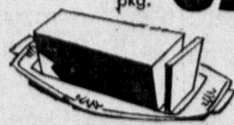

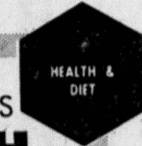
